The institute/congregation of the LSOSF has now gradually expanded and presently the sisters are working in Kenya, Uganda and Tanzania in order to reach the poor and the needy, which they are called to love and serve.

The area of involvement therefore include: Working in Religious institutes, education work at all levels, catering, Social work, Secretarial work, agricultural projects, Journeying, taking care of the deaf and dumb, Orphans and the aged people, taking care of refugees and street children, nursing care, and above all rehabilitating the Disabled and helping them in all ways possible so as to live quality life.

MISSION: To reach out with compassion to the marginalized in the spirit of St. Francis and mother Kevin.
